Well, we're off and running. Our goal as a booster organization is to support our students in the F.I.R.S.T. Club both in spirit and in finances. So...that means we will be doing some major fundraising. Our goal is to raise enough funds to send the team to the various competitions, without having to have families pay a portion of the cost. This entire project runs upwards of \$100,00.00. We are fortunate in that the General Motors Proving Grounds, our corporate partner, is very generous, and contributes about \$70,000.00 to the project. The remainder is up to us to raise.

So, read on... we already have some projects underway and are in need of parent and student involvement in all aspects of our fundraising.

Candy Sales

We have just completed an in-school candy sale. We had 50 cent and dollar candy for sale, which the students were able to sell in both high schools. This sale did not raise as much money as we had hoped.

We still have some outstanding money from the sale, so please check with your student to be sure they turned in all candy money. If any parents are interested in taking candy to work to sell, we still have some left.

We will be having another candy sale after the first of the year. Stay tuned ...

Pop Bottle Receipts

Another ongoing fund-raiser will be pop

bottle returns. We will be approaching this in several different ways.

First, we are asking you to save your pop bottle return receipts and have your student turn them in at their meetings or bring them to the parent booster meetings.

We will also be soliciting bottles from the community. We will have designated days in the upcoming months where we will have volunteers posted at area grocery stores to ask shoppers for their bottles. We will also send out fliers telling residents that our students will be happy to pick up bottles from their homes on certain dates.

Our first such drive occurred on Sunday Nov. 29th. We had only a small group of students participating. The greater the participation, the greater the outcome. Watch for upcoming dates. .

Valentine's Day Dinner Dance

We are planning a Valentine's Day Dinner Dance scheduled for Saturday Feb. 13th at Baker's of Milford. We will have a full dinner, with a choice of two entrees, side dishes and dessert. And a DJ for dancing the night away. This event was a rousing success last year, and raised over \$16,000.00.

Silent Auction

At the Dinner Dance we will also be hosting a silent auction. We will be soliciting items for auction from businesses

throughout the area.

We will need volunteers to assist in soliciting donations (we have the beginnings of a great list of potential donors!), inventorying our donations, setting up the auction and working the auction the night of the dinner dance. Please let us know where you can help.

If you own a business, and would like to donate a product or gift certificate, please let us know. If you work for a company that may donate something, (a product, gift certificate, tickets to sports events, week-end get away, etc.) we want to talk to you!

Our F.I.R.S.T. Store - The HOT Spot

Once again, we have had a property owner in downtown Milford graciously donate to us the use of their store for the upcoming holiday season. Students and parents have worked endless hours cleaning and setting up the store and making craft items to stock it.

If you, or your student, are a crafter, and would like to sell your craft in our store on consignment and donate a percentage of the proceeds to F.I.R.S.T., please contact us.

The HOT Spot, located at the corner of Main Street and West Huron, will be open every weekend until Christmas. Hours will be Friday evenings from 5 to 9 PM, Saturday from 10 to 6 and Sunday from 12 to 6. We will need parents and students to volunteer for at least two hour shifts to operate the store and to do gift wrapping.

Garage Sale
